It is physically impossible for a well-educated, intellectual or brave man to make money the chief object of his thoughts just as it is for him to make his dinner the principal object of them. All healthy people like their dinners, but their dinner is not the main object of their lives. So all healthy minded people like making money ought to like it and enjoy the sensation of winning it; it is something better than money. A good soldier, for instance, mainly wishes to do his fighting well. He is glad of his pay – very properly so and justly grumbles when you keep him ten years without it -till, his main mission of life is to win battles, not to be paid for winning them.

ANSWER:-

It is **PHYSICALLY IMPOSSIBLE** for a **WELL-EDUCATED**, **INTELLECTUAL** or **BRAVE MAN** to make **MONEY** the **CHIEF OBJECT** of his thoughts just as it is for him to make his dinner the **PRINCIPAL OBJECT** of them. All **HEALTHY PEOPLE** like their **DINNERS**, but their dinner is **NOT THE MAIN OBJECT** of their lives. So all **HEALTHY MINDED** people like **MAKING MONEY** ought to like it and **ENJOY** the **SENSATION OF WINNING** it; it is something better than money. A **GOOD SOLDIER**, for instance, mainly **WISHES** to do his **FIGHTING** well. He is glad of his **PAY** – very properly so and **JUSTLY GRUMBLES** when you keep him **TEN YEARS WITHOUT** it – till, his **main MISSION** of life is to **WIN BATTLES**, **NOT TO BE PAID** for winning them.

Q.5: Suppose you are to give some health related instructions to your friend on phone who is suffering from diarrhea, what instructions would you give him/her? Study Unit 3, Section A for learning how to form instructive sentences. (10) Example: You should have only liquid food.

ANSWER:-

- i. The most important is to keep your hands clean.
- ii. Always wash fresh fruits and veggies as the surfaces of fresh produce (fruits and veggies) are very commonly contaminated with bacteria (such as E. coli) and parasites.
- iii. Remember to drink clean water. The tap water where you live may not taste very good.
- iv. Always cook perishable food thoroughly.
- v. Avoid foods that can trigger diarrhea. Some foods have a tendency to create some stomach / intestinal irritation or spasms, which can trigger short-term bouts of diarrhea.
- vi. Steer clear of dairy if you're lactose intolerant because it is the inability to produce enough enzyme (lactase) needed to properly digest milk sugar (lactose).
- vii. See your doctor if diarrhea is a common problem for you.
- viii. Ask your doctor about antibiotics.
- ix. Consider taking herbal remedies as natural medicines made from plant products are often a good alternative to pharmaceutical preparations in preventing and treating diarrhea.
